- As lecture(s) and seminar(s) presenting the results of the field projects at Urla / Klazomenai directed by me under the auspices of the Ministry of Culture andf Tourism and Hitit University,
- To inform about the current trends and results of the Ionian art and archaeology to the Italian colleagues and students.
- To improve potential collaborative studies between the two institutions, namely University of Florence and Hitit University.
- To present informal seminars, if needed, to graduate students about the Archaeology of the Early Iron Age in the Eastern Aegean;
- To use the research library at the University of Florence during this brief period;
- To gain an experience of the departmental management in a foreign instutition.

- To share different approaches and methodologies in an academic environment and to interact with faculty as well as the student body (both at the undergraduate as well as the graduate level) with presentations and lectures on Archaeology of the Eastern Aegean and Ionia during the Bronze Age / Iron Age as well as the Archaic period,
- To gain new learning approaches following the interaction with the colleagues at the hosting institution;
- To enhance direct experience on academic, cultural as well as social and economical spheres at the hosting institute;
- To have a familiarity of European consciousness and multi-cultural understanding and adopting it as skills to my own teaching experience in my own university at Corum, Turkey;
- By being at the foreign institution as a multi-cultural environment, although as a rather brief period, I expect to receive a cultural experience which will be stimulating both for creativity in teaching as well as the potential collaborative efforts between the two institutions;
