SYNOPSIS

My name is Raffaele Ranieri. I am the co-director of the International Archaeological mission "Medieval Petra – Shobak Project" of the University of Florence in Jordan. Additionally, I serve as teaching assistant (cultore della materia) for the chair of Medieval Archaeology (teacher: prof. Michele Nucciotti) at the University of Florence and I am member of the Italian Medieval Archaeoogist Society (SAMI). I obtained a PhD in Islamic Archaeology from the University of Bonn, based in the Institute for Oriental and Asian studies/Department of Islamic Studies, where my supervisor was Prof. Dr. Bethany J. Walker. My thesis focused on the material culture of Southern Bilad-al-Sham during the Crusader, Ayyubid and Mamluk periods. In the past years I worked as postdoctoral research fellow at the Sagas Department (University of Florence) within the project AICS (Italian Agency For Development Cooperation) Programme to support socioeconomic recovery in the protected area of Shobak (scientific coordinator: prof. Michele Nucciotti) and adjunct professor of Medieval Archaeology of Islamic Lands at the Specialization School in Archaeology - University of Florence. For the past 10 years I have been involved in several international archaeological projects (including excavations, light and landscape archaeology, public archaeology, material culture/archaeology of production and 3D photogrammetry) taking on responsibilities as field/square supervisor and pottery specialist (Petra-Shawbak, Hisban in Jordan, and several sites in Italy). Furthermore, I have been serving as a lab tutor in Material Culture for the BA and MA programs in Heritage Studies and Medieval Archaeology at the University of Florence.
